




"I can't wait to grow up and become a nurse," said Lily. "They are heroes because they help sick people feel better."








"I want to be a hero!" screamed Lily. "Me too!" replied James. "But how?" asked Ryan.

"We can be heroes by helping stop this new virus," replied Ms. Mary.









"You're both right. The virus can be called coronavirus, COVID, or COVID-19."

"A virus is a germ that is so tiny you can't even see it with your eyes. It can make you sick once it's inside your body," explained Ms. Mary.










"Not that way! That's not how we fight the virus," laughed Ms. Mary. "There are three simple things we can do to help stop this virus, especially when we are not at home."

"Just like a firefighter using water to put out a fire!" screamed James.




"The second thing we can do is to keep our distance from one another so the virus can't reach us."
